Standard curriculum

The standard curriculum shows one of several ways in which you can plan your studies. It represents a full-time study load of 6 semesters. In the Major/Minor combination (180 ECTS credits in total), you can earn approximately 30 ECTS credits per semester. It is also possible to earn a lower amount of ECTS credits per semester. In this case, the duration of your studies will be extended accordingly. For the Minor in East Asian Art History, we recommend starting your studies in the Fall Semester.
